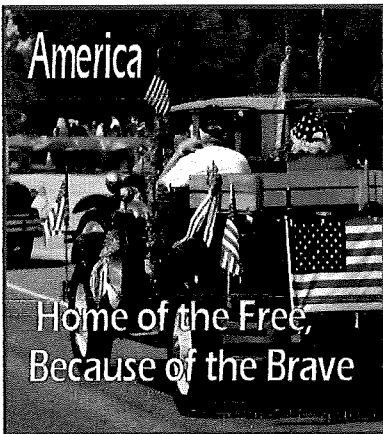


Saturday, October 31st at noon in the Clubhouse parking lot
