## CRESTWOOD VILLAGE AT FREDERICK

### SWIMMING POOL RULES

Use of the Crestwood Village swimming pool will be at the user's risk. The Homeowners' Association (HOA) is not responsible for any injury, illness or loss of personal property while using the pool. All injuries occurring on the premises must be reported immediately to the pool life guard, the HOA office, the Clubhouse desk or security.

#### POOL SEASON:

- **Opening and closing:** The pool opens the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. It closes the Monday of Labor Day weekend.
- **Pool hours:**

Monday, Wednesday and Friday . . . . .	11:00 AM – 6:00 PM
Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday and Holidays* . . . . .	11:00 AM – 7:00 PM
Saturday . . . . .	12 Noon – 8:00 PM

\*Holidays: Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day
- **Exercise class:**

Monday, Wednesday and Friday . . . . .	10:00 AM – 11:00 AM

**This pool time is reserved for class participants only.**

**SIGN-IN:** All members/**residents** and their guests must sign in at the Clubhouse desk or at the lifeguard station before using the pool. If the Clubhouse is not open, members and guests must sign in at the lifeguard station.

**MEMBER/RESIDENT IDENTIFICATION:** Member identification is important when using the Clubhouse facilities. Name badges may be obtained at the HOA office. Name badges are not transferable.

- A Pool Pass card will be issued to any resident desiring to use the pool. This card must be shown upon signing in to use the pool.
- A Guest Pass card must be shown anytime a resident brings a guest to the pool. A Guest Pass card must be purchased at the Clubhouse desk for an individual day or for the year. If a resident purchases an annual guest pass, the resident will be issued five (5) Guest Pass cards to permit up to five guests at any one time to use the pool.
- The resident is responsible for their Pool Pass and Guest Pass cards. A fee will be charged for any replacement.

#### CONCERNING THE USE OF THE POOL BY RESIDENTS AND GUESTS:

##### GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Use of the pool is prohibited unless a certified lifeguard is on duty.
- Management or the lifeguard reserves the right to close the pool at any time because of inclement weather or mechanical failure.

- Users/**Everyone** must clear the pool when directed by the lifeguard for scheduled breaks, chemical testing, maintenance tasks, **requested adult swim times**, etc.
- **No one is to enter the pool with health issues such as a cough, cold, skin disorder, open cuts, etc.** No person should enter the pool if his/her health does not warrant such entry, such as having a cough, cold, skin disorder, open cut, etc.
- Shower before entering the pool.
- Proper swim wear is required. No cutoffs or **bermudas/shorts** are permitted in the pool.
- Sitting, playing or congregating on or around the stairs and railings is prohibited. for safety reasons.
- No running, diving or jumping into the pool.
- Objects permitted in the pool are noodles, kickboards during exercise classes only, **water weights** and balls in an adult-structured and supervised activity.
- Objects such as inner tubes, snorkels, toys, bubbles, etc. are not allowed in the pool.
- Sunbathing is confined to the pool deck level. Sunbathing at the swimming pool is to be confined to the pool level and is not to be permitted on any other levels of the pool facility.
- No smoking or e-cigarettes are permitted. No smoking is permitted in the Clubhouse or on Clubhouse grounds.
- Inappropriate behavior of any kind will not be tolerated in the pool or surrounding areas.
- Pool rules will be posted on the fence at the pool deck entrance gate.

#### **CONCERNING GUESTS:**

- **All guests are to be in the company of an adult resident.**
- EXCEPTION: After being personally signed in by the resident, Only a resident's adult children and their immediate family may use the pool without the resident being on site. The responsible adult(s) under this circumstance must remain at the pool and have knowledge of and strictly comply with all Crestwood Village rules and regulations.
- **A resident may have only five guests at any one time.**

#### **CONCERNING CHILDREN:**

- Guests or resident children under the age of 18 must be in the company of and under the direct supervision of an adult resident **or a resident's adult child. See the exception stated above.** For the purpose of this document an adult is anyone 18 years of age or older.
- Crestwood Village II resident children under the age of 18 may use the swimming pool without a parent/guardian on site once written parental permission has been received in the HOA office and the child has passed a swim test administered by the lifeguard. Permission forms may be obtained in the HOA office.
- Residents under the age of 18 are not allowed to have guests unless in the company of and under the direct supervision of an adult resident.
- **No children under the age of three are permitted in the pool. This includes sitting along the pool edge.** Only toilet-trained children can use the pool. No diapers, swim diapers, pull-ups or rubber pants are allowed in the pool.
- Children may use swimming or confidence aids such as life jackets, back floats, water wings and built-in bathing suit floats as long as an adult is in the **water/pool** and supervising the child using these devices.

- Sitting, playing or congregating on or around the pool stairs and railings is prohibited. for safety reasons.
- There is to be no diving or jumping **into the pool**.
- There is to be no running **on the pool deck level**.
- Residents and their **adult** guests shall **be/are** responsible for the behavior and safety of children under their care.
- **There will be a 15 minute adult swim time whenever there are 6 or more children using the pool and an adult swim time is requested by a resident.**

#### **CONCERNING FOOD AND BEVERAGES:**

- Glass containers are strictly prohibited **at/on** the pool **deck** level.
- Only water in unbreakable containers is permitted **on the pool deck level**.
- Food and beverages are not permitted in the lower concrete deck area surrounding the pool/**on the pool deck level**.
- All waste is to be deposited in trash receptacles.

#### **CONCERNING ACCESS TO THE CLUBHOUSE:**

- Rear doors to the Clubhouse will be open so residents and their guests will have access to the Clubhouse locker rooms when the Clubhouse is open.
- Clothes and belongings are to be placed in Clubhouse lockers and not on benches or in the dressing areas.
- You will need to remove all personal items from the Clubhouse lockers before the Clubhouse closes when the pool is remaining open. **All personal belongings must be removed from the Clubhouse a half hour before the Clubhouse closes.**

**The lifeguard is in charge of the pool area at all times and may take any action deemed necessary for the health and safety of residents and guests.**
